


PUBLICATIONS AND BOOKS

Batboys and the World of Baseball: Though scores of gung-ho fans have envied the glamour and the privileged insider's experiences that only a batboy can enjoy, most spectators take him for granted. Neil Isaacs, the author, remedies this situation and gives us a unique view from the perspective of generations of batboys. 232 pages, illustrated, soft cover. Price: \$15.95


MADE IN THE USA: Over the years, Renato Corazza, *Bulletin* editor in the early 80's, has produced a series of photo works he called *Made In The USA*. They depict boys of many cultures in their everyday pursuits. Some photos are of nude boys but are well within Federal laws governing prohibited images. These soft cover books are 50 pages in approximately letter size format. Front and rear covers are in color. Other photos are black and white. Renato was a graphic artist, and his books reflect his inimitable style. Those who are familiar with the long out of print *The Boy* and *Boys Will Be Boys* will appreciate the appeal of this offer and the excellent value it represents. Renato died years ago, so there are now only eight books in the series. #1 through #4 are available only from our rare items section Issues #5 through #8 are \$19.95






Alcibiades the Schoolboy: Described as the first gay novel, this 17th Century Italian work of fiction (translated into English) is an erotic dialogue between a boy and his tutor where the latter seduces the boy. **124 pages, soft cover. Price:** \$ **19.95** Not currently available

The Moralist by Rod Downey: Tom O'Carroll, author of *Pedophilia: The Radical Case* says "Read it if you dare. *The Moralist* is brilliant and outrageous. It is about things that matter: art, philosophy, politics, science, and religion. Above all, it is a love story, and one like no other. Misunderstood Intimacy – A Pastoral Approach to Pedophilia: Published in English by Stichting voor Kerkelijk Sociale Arbeid (Foundation for Church Social Work). This Dutch publication is the product of work done through Pauluskerk (St. Paul's Church) in Rotterdam and its pastor Rev. Hans Visser. It is a work of tolerance and understanding and highly recommended reading. Though the word "pedophilia" has assumed the role of a pejorative in English speaking countries the term has retained a more benign meaning within continental Europe.


Pedophiles on Parade by David Sonenschein: Pedophiles On Parade is the finest analysis of Child Molester Hysteria that we have seen. The author fearlessly reveals how adult villains, child victims, and heroic authority figures are invented and reinforced by the government, the media, and special interest groups with repressive social agendas.

Volume 1, The Monster In the Media, uses data collected over a decade to document popular ideas of adult-youth sexual relations from the mid-1970s into the 1990s, a period now known as the child sexual abuse hysteria. Looking critically at both fiction (including film) and journalism, core elements of villains, victims, and heroes are drawn out and shown to be interconnected. Sources widely distributed as well as those inaccessible to others are examined and tied to a variety of products and processes of American culture to yield the most complete and in-depth study yet available of this crucial period and issue.

Volume 2, The Popular Imagery Of Moral Hysteria, uses the child sex abuse hysteria of the 1980s as a reference point for a far-ranging cultural historical survey of the ways sexual villains, victims, and heroes have been constructed and used in America. Including an extensive and unique chapter on "The Sexual Child" - one of the most avoided and undocumented subjects in history. *Pedophiles On Parade* is one of the finest exposés we have seen on how "reality" is created, and is must reading for all thinking people. **2-volume set, 570 combined pp, illustrated, indexed, soft cover. This Too is Love: Each of the twelve stories that make up this work is complete in itself. Yet together they compose a small photo album of one man's struggle to come to terms with his inclinations toward a forbidden love. In the first story the protagonist is a boy himself, and gains the attention of the man who is his swimming instructor. In the succeeding stories this boy has become a man, and we see him as a counselor at an institution for juvenile delinquents, and then as a social worker. 265 pages, soft cover. Price: \$ 16.95





Deviant Justice exposes the treatment of a new type of witch. The atrocities once visited on witches of yore are now repugnant to Western societies. But the moral panics that prompted such ancient barbarity continue, always aimed at vulnerable minorities. Now, in the US, so called sex offenders are locked away forever under the devious pretext of curing them. What are really lifetime extensions of prison are called "civil commitment" and "preventive detention." The torture of the body has now been replaced by the torture of the mind and the soul.

We may no longer be burning witches but we are in great danger of burning our Constitution and the bulwark to our freedoms.




